ARMOR OF GOD MEMORY MATCH

SUPPLIES:

- [Armor of God Memory Match Cards](#) (print them from online or make your own)

WHAT TO DO:

- Play a matching game using the pieces of the armor of God. Print the cards or make your own using the ones online as a sample. You should have 14 cards total – two of each piece of armor. Mix up the cards then lay them picture side down where everyone can see them.
- The first player will turn over two cards to reveal the picture on each. If they are a match, the player gets to keep the cards. If they don't match, turn them face down in their place and the next player takes a turn trying to discover two matching cards. Continue playing till all of the matches have been found.

BIBLE STORY REVIEW

SUPPLIES:

- [Bible Story Review Cards](#) (print them or look at them online)

WHAT TO DO:

- Take turns choosing a Bible Story Card and telling what you know about the Bible story. You could act it out charades style, draw it Pictionary style, or read it in the Bible.

ZONK REVIEW GAME

SUPPLIES:

- Dice, [ZONK Questions](#), [ZONK Answers](#)

WHAT TO DO:

- Now that you've reviewed the Bible stories from this series, play a game of ZONK together! Click on the ZONK Questions to begin. You can divide into teams or play individually. Have the first person or team give their answer to the question, then click on the ZONK Answers to see if the answer is correct. Pause the game after each question is answered to give the teams a chance to roll the dice for points. (See below)

SCORING FOR ZONK:

- Teams will take turns answering a ZONK question. If the team answers correctly, they receive 10 points.
- Then, they get to roll the dice to try and gain additional points for their team. If they roll numbers 2 through 6, they get points according to the number they rolled (for example, if a 4 is rolled the team gets 4 points)
- Teams can roll the dice as many times as they want to during that round. HOWEVER, if they roll a "1" they lose ALL of their points for that round!! (points received from previous rounds are not lost)
- Continue playing until all of the questions have been answered.

FAMILY ACTIVITY – PRAYER WALK

WHAT TO DO:

- Go on a prayer walk as a family! First, walk around both inside and outside your house. Pray for each person in your family, ask God to help you make good choices as a family, to share God's love with others.
- Then, plan a prayer walk around your neighborhood. Pray for those who live around you to know and follow God, to have God's blessings, to be healthy, and to know God loves them.
- After your prayer walk, enjoy a treat together and talk about some other ways you can be a blessing to your neighbors.

SHIELD OF ARMOR

SUPPLIES:

- [Shield of Armor](#) (print one from online or use the one online to draw your own)

WHAT TO DO:

- Decorate a shield of armor with each of the pieces of armor we have learned about in this series. (see them on the left side of this page)
- Put it in a place where you will see it every day and be reminded to put on God's armor. You might put it in a place where you pray or where you will see it before you leave your house.

PRAY THROUGH GOD'S ARMOR

- Pray together as a family. Have a place to write down prayer requests that are shared and answered prayers, too.
- Pray through the armor of God –
 - ~ ask God to help you know what is true and to not be tricked by lies
 - ~ pray to have courage to obey God, do what is right, and protect your heart
 - ~ ask God to help you share the good news about Jesus with others
 - ~ pray to have strength to hold up your shield of faith and stay strong trusting God
 - ~ pray to use your helmet to protect your mind and your thoughts and to know Jesus has saved you
 - ~ ask God to help you learn more and more of His Word, the Bible, to fight against lies of the enemy
 - ~ finally, pray to be able to stand firm and pray at all times because prayer is a powerful weapon!
