LET'S GET STARTED!

SUPPLIES:

- [Bible Trivia Sheets](#), paper for each person and something to write with

WHAT TO DO:

- Ask the questions from the Bible Trivia Sheets and have everyone write down their answers on a piece of paper. Check your answers on the answer key on the last page. Who got the most answers correct?

SHARE TOGETHER:

- Take turns answering this question: "Which would you rather do, go sailing on the ice or climb to the top of the highest mountain?"
- Those are only two of the extremely awesome things you can do in the great outdoors. But you can't just go right to ice sailing or climbing a big mountain. First, you have to take the time to read and find out how to do those things. In the same way, when we read God's Word, the Bible, we will find out more about Him, and our friendship with Him will grow. And that's what we need to know! So say this after me:

I Can Read God's Word

BIBLE STORY

SUPPLIES:

WHAT TO DO:

- Read the Bible Story Cards to learn about when Jesus spent some time reading God's Word.
- You can also read it in the Bible in Luke 4:14-21; Luke 24:45, John 5:39.

ASK:

- Why do you think it's important for us to read God's Word?
- If you don't understand something you read in the Bible, what can you do?
- What are some things you know about who God is? (make a list of all of the things that are named)

20 QUESTIONS

SUPPLIES:

- [Leader Guide, List of objects for 20 Questions](#)

WHAT TO DO:

- Play a game of 20 Questions with a list of animals and musical instruments that are all found in the Bible!
- The first person secretly chooses an animal or a musical instrument from the list. The others will ask yes and no questions to try and guess the animal or instrument. For example, someone could ask, "Is it an animal?" If the answer is yes, then someone could ask, "Does the animal walk on four legs?" Continue with yes and no questions until the object is guessed correctly. Once it is guessed, ask a question from the Leader Guide. Continue playing until all of the questions from the Leader Guide have been asked.

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MEMORY VERSE

- Continue learning the Memory Verse. Say it with the motions below or make up some of your own.
 - God, (point up)
 - You are my God. (thumbs to chest)
 - I want to follow you. (walk in place)
 - Psalm 63:1 (make book with hands)

READING GOD'S WORD

- Jesus love to read and learn God's word, and He was God's Son! He knew reading and knowing God's word helped him to do all that God had for him to do. And that is true for us, too. God wants us to read and know His word so we will know what God has for US to do!
- Talk together and make a plan to read and learn God's word together as a family. You might choose a book of the Bible to read together like the book of Mark or Luke in the New Testament.
