



### DAILY OBJECTIVE

Kids will learn that God's power, not our own, makes us heroes.

### Need To Know

God's Power In Me Makes Me a Hero!

### Bible Story

Who is the True God?  
1 Kings 18

**DIRECTED PLAY TIME** Take this time to connect with your students on an individual level and get to know each other better.

#### WELCOME

SAY: **Welcome friends! My name is (YOUR NAME), and I am your leader today. We are starting a new series in class called "Heroes and Villains"! Let's go around the circle and when we get to you, say your name and answer this question: If you could have one super power, what would it be?**

SAY: **Having a super power is not what really makes us heroes. It is God's power in us that makes us heroes! He's more powerful and greater than anything else. Let's say the Need To Know together (repeat it a couple times together):**

**God's Power In Me Makes Me A Hero!**

#### BIBLE STORY

- SAY: **There is a time in the Bible where many people were worshipping a false god. But there was one man who knew how powerful God is, so he relied on God's power in him to show the people that God is the one true God.**
- Have kids get ready to hear the Bible story by clicking on their listening ears and putting on their special eyes.
- Read the Bible Story – **The Beginners Bible page 209-215**
- Discuss the following questions WHILE reading. You can award Harbor Bucks for kids who answer the questions
  - Who were the people worshipping: a false god named Baal or a clown named Bob? (a false god named Baal)
  - True or false: Elijah poured milk on the altar to God. (false; he poured water on the altar)
  - Did people start worshipping God once they saw how powerful He was? (Yes; they bowed and worshipped the One True God)
  - Whose power did Elijah rely on? (God's power!)



## MEMORY VERSE

“God’s Spirit is in you  
(point to heart)

And is more powerful  
(flex muscles)

Than the one that is in the world.”  
(make a “1” with one hand)

1 John 4:4

**SAY:** Just like Elijah relied on God’s power in him to show the people how powerful God is, we can rely on God’s power in us when we are facing any challenge. It is only God’s power, not our own, that makes us heroes!

## HERO MASKS

**SUPPLIES:** paper mask, sticker, stamps and crayons

1. SAY: **It is only God’s power in us, not anything else, that makes us heroes. Let’s make a hero mask to remember that God shows His power through us!**
2. Pass out paper masks to each child.
3. Let the kids decorate their hero masks. They can color or use the stickers and stamps available.
4. As kids color, ask them what kind of super powers they think God has/gives them? ( think through the fruit and gifts of the Spirit)
  - Peace - Faithfulness - Miracles
  - Patience - Gentleness - Prophecy
  - Goodness - Self-control - Discernment
  - Love - Wisdom - Tongues
  - Joy - Faith - Interpretation of tongues
  - Kindness - Healing - Words of Knowledge
5. As kids wrap up decorating say: **It is God’s power alone that makes us heroes because He is greater than any other power in the world!**

## SUPER POWER BOWLING

**Supplies:** bowling pins, bowling ball

1. SAY: God’s power at work in us makes us superheroes! Let’s practice using God’s Power to take down the pins of evil!
2. Set up the bowling pins at one end of the classroom
3. Have kids line up and take turns bowling with “God’s Power”.
4. Encourage kids that God’s power knocks down evil every time!

## SNACK TIME

Make sure to give kids a “raindrop” (a drop of hand sanitizer) before passing out snack and water. Ask if anyone in the class would like to pray for snack.



## HARBOR BUCKS

Hey Teachers, don't forget about our classroom rewards, Harbor Bucks!

This is a few ways to encourage kids as they continue to grow. Here are some examples of reasons to hand out Harbor Bucks to kids:

- Bring their Bible
- Say the memory verse
- Bring a friend or first-time friends
- Have good behavior

Kids can trade in their Harbor Bucks for prizes at the Harbor Bank! The Harbor Bank is open every Sunday for kids to redeem their Harbor Bucks

## PRAYING POWER

Supplies: prayer sheets

1. SAY: One way that God used His power through Elijah was when Elijah prayed! Our prayers are powerful and God shows His power through them! Let's practice the power of prayer.
2. Pass out prayer sheets to all the kids. Have kids write/draw out some prayer request.
3. Have kids pray for one another in class. You can either send kids home with prayer request or hang them up on the prayer board in class.
4. Let's say our Need To Know together!

## MEMORY VERSE

Say and do the motions several times while kids repeat after you.

Tell kids that we are learning a new verse today. They can go home and practice this verse throughout the week! When they memorize it, they can get a Harbor Buck!

## STAY TOGETHER



Keep kids engaged until they are checked out by doing any of the following:

- Give each child a coloring sheet to color as you ask them:
  - Did you have fun at church today?
  - What did you learn?
  - Who is your favorite superhero?
- Play “Superhero Says”, like the game “Simon Says” and let kids take turns being the superhero.
